



Minimum Data Set (MDSv2)

The Minimum Data Set (MDS) module provides for easy-to-create MDS assessments that are ready for electronic transmission to the State. Included are also printed reports and analysis, and:

- The Smart Chart feature which enables the end-user to access all clinical modules for a given resident.
- Available MDS assessments: Full Assessment, MPAF, Quarterly Assessment, Reentry Tracking, Discharge Tracking.
- Quality Indicators are triggered and immediately displayed on the entry screen.
- The Incomplete and Inconsistencies Audit feature allows for instant completion of sections instead of re-entering each section.
- The “Changes” button displays measurable differences in a resident’s condition from one assessment to the next. It provides an instant alert of whether a comprehensive assessment may be warranted.
- It features a familiar visual format as a paper MDS that all users will recognize and be more comfortable using.
- Disciplines have the functionality to move from resident to resident from within the MDS assessment.
- CMS672 and 802 reports are instantly available, based on the latest assessments. On-screen instructions are provided for completing each section of the report as well as access to the MDS item that triggered the response.
- Quality Indicator Reports are easily generated prior to MDS transmission to enable ongoing and real-time QA analysis.
- Demographic information automatically flows to the MDS from the resident profile. This feature helps to minimize duplication of efforts and reduces the likelihood of errors.
- RUG scores are re-calculated in real-time and RUG scores are automatically transferred into the 1st & 3rd Party Billing area.
- The MDS module automatically schedules both OBRA and PPS assessments.
- Quarterly assessments include full and first through third quarter comparative data.
- Access to online RAI Manual from the MDS module.
- Print preview functionality allows the user to see and select the pages they wish to print of the MDS.
- The MDS module maintains the highest level of compliance with all Federal and State mandates as well as all state-specific forms and section requirements.
- The electronic transmission feature includes the latest version of the data specs. Forms are standardized to duplicate the state forms and reduce time on resubmissions.
- Provides for easy batching of electronic files.
