



# Medical Records

The Medical Records module provides for easy-to-create physicians orders, MARS and TARS as well as printed reports and analysis. Multiple systems for tracking infections, incidents, falls, skin condition, TB Screening and Immunizations, vital signs, ID notes and weight provide the opportunity to effectively manage resident care. Other functions include:

- Unique Tickler List tracks procedures and notifies users when various functions are due such as: labs, weights, vaccinations, etc.
- With the click of a button, users can quickly and accurately produce Standing Orders for common medical conditions.
- A tracking system for Vital Signs provides the ability to set out of range values that alerts the staff to changes in a resident's condition.
- eMAR/eTAR/eCNA Flow provides for an Electronic Point of Care which allows the user to define specific times, location, and sequence for medication administration, treatments and CNA functions.
- It also offers a "pour then pass" feature that is linked to drug interactions, gives recommended dosage by age, weight and disease process, displays medication, food and environment allergy information, all with severity rating and also displays monograph.
- The ability to send Physician Orders to pharmacy via e-Fax.
- Electronic signatures with "supervisor" sign off functionality.
- Offers the ability to print out psychotropic drug orders and lab draws.
- Provides the ability to document immunizations given to the resident. Influenza and Pneumococcal vaccines information entered can be automatically transferred to the CMS 672.
- A Physician Out of the Facility Report can be printed in seconds and provides a two-way communication of current resident medical information as well as a means for the medical provider to relay outcomes of a visit, new orders, and next visit details.
- The Interdisciplinary Notes provides an easy tool for entering, sorting, and reviewing clinical documentation.
- Incident Tracking provides a systematic approach for tracking occurrences within the facility.
- Infection Tracking provides an easy to use system for tracking infections and for ongoing analysis.
- Wound Care Tracking monitors skin conditions and includes report capabilities. The MDS is also automatically updated.
